

EGTC Privacy Notice

The categories of Club Members information that we collect, process, hold and share include:

- Membership contract information:
 - Name, date of birth, gender, address, email address
 - Emergency contact information
 - Relevant medical information
- EGTC training data (e.g. Turbo heart rate test results, swim CSS results, Club Winter GP results)

Why we collect and use this information

We use member information data to:

- Enable the development of a comprehensive picture of the member to assist with progression in the sport
- Enable members to progress onto higher level competitions
- Inform members about Club news and events and the development of the sport
- Provide members access to training information and results

The lawful basis on which we process this information

We process this information under the membership contract you have entered into with **East Grinstead Triathlon Club (EGTC)** or in relation to the steps taken to enter into that contract.

Where information of a non-sensitive nature is processed and is therefore in the Club's legitimate interests i.e. membership of the club. Where sensitive data is processed by means of consent, with appropriate safeguards and is in the legitimate interests of the Club or is in your vital interests.

The membership information and EGTC training data listed above is considered to be covered under the membership contract.

Collecting this information

Whilst the majority of information you provide to us is mandatory, some of it is provided to us on a voluntary basis. In order to comply with data protection legislation, we will inform you whether you are required to provide certain membership information to us or if you have a choice in this.

If we rely on your consent for collecting your data, you have the right to withdraw your consent at any time. To do so please contact the EGTC Secretary secretary@egtri.com

Storing this information

We hold your data for the duration of your membership with the club. Where we have invoiced for items or collected payments, the Club will retain your information for 7 years. Where you have been involved in a reported accident or welfare incident during a club training session, we will retain for the report for 3 years. Membership contract information will be renewed every year when members renew their club membership.

Unless otherwise stated, membership contract information and training data will be retained for up to 1 year after you leave the club.

Who we share this information with

We routinely share this information with:

- British Triathlon / Triathlon England

The reason for sharing your with British Triathlon data is to highlight and encourage competitors to advance in the sport. Or to apply for further funding to ensure the sport's or club's longevity.

Why we share membership information

We do not share information about members with anyone without consent unless the law and our policies allow us to do so.

Your rights

You have rights as an individual which you can exercise in relation to the information we hold about you. These include the right to:

- Object to processing of personal data that is likely to cause, or is causing, damage or distress
- Prevent processing for the purpose of direct marketing
- Object to decisions being taken by automated means
- In certain circumstances, have inaccurate personal data rectified, blocked, erased or destroyed; and
- Claim compensation for damages caused by a breach of the Data Protection regulations
